This certificate of authorisation is granted in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 19 (1) and 30 (1) of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 ["National Authorisation"] and regulation 5 of the Biocidal Products and Chemicals (Appointment of Authorities and Enforcement) Regulations 2013 and the Biocidal Products and Chemicals (Appointment of Authorities and Enforcement) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2013.

The conditions in Article 19 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 have been met.

The Health and Safety Executive, on behalf of the Secretary of State (as regards England), the Scottish Ministers (as regards Scotland), the Welsh Ministers (as regards Wales) and the Health and Safety Executive for Northern Ireland (as regards Northern Ireland), pursuant to agency agreements coming into force on 1 September 2013 grant this certificate of authorisation in the following terms:

1. Subject to compliance with paragraph 2 and the condition(s) listed in Appendix 3, the authorisation holder is authorised to place on the market the biocidal product detailed in the Summary of the Product Characteristics in Appendices 1 and 2, for the use(s) set out in Appendix 1.
2. The authorisation holder shall complete, within the stated timeframe, the actions set out in the table below. If the actions have not been completed by the relevant due date, the biocidal product covered by this certificate of authorisation may no longer be placed on the market as of that date.

A new 12 month ambient storage stability study determining the tebuconazole content at 0, 6 and 12 months using a validated method of analysis, with less than 3% interference on the tebuconazole peak is to be provided	At renewal of the product authorisation

4. This certificate of authorisation may be cancelled in the circumstances set out in Articles 48 and 49 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012.
5. Subject to paragraphs 3 and 4, this certificate of authorisation remains in force until midnight 4th June 2023
